


Dear, South Carolina court of appeals

This is Robert L. Jones, Jr I'm writing this letter in regards of my court case thank you for receiving and replying to my problem. I see on the letter that I was sent from your, is that you would like me to provide a reason for an arguable basis for an appeal, well I'm gonna tell you now.

I Robert L. Jones, Jr was locked up for 91 days in Orangeburg complex I toughed it out because I had four seizures in there even one in the courtroom at my first bond hearing. I didn't get proper treatment I also had major foot swelling, dizzy spells, and depression problems. I can't run no more with my legs. It hurts when I walk, the nurses at the complex had me on four strict medicines to try to stop seizures and foot and legs swelling. It wasn't the best but it did temporarily ease pain, but it was not good enough. I had a option at first and that was to bond out, but I figured I save the money for my family and bills and do 90 days with goodtime to be suspended to 63 days but trails got in my way I also was a houseman for the pod I was in that was more goodtime I still did 91 days which was lesson learned I was aiming for time served and no probation or nothing, because my body conditions, my financial life and income is rough and I also have no transportation and stay from town. I'm looking forward to disability services and going to get a full physical I hope they don't have to cut my legs. I'm truly in pain and I don't want to make it worse, Also when I went to court I just finish taking my medicines that morning they made me take it they said it's a must I also ask them to release my medical forms several times but they steady was saying they gonna get them but never did it I guess they had a feeling I was gonna sue, but freedom and my health was more important, I also got to get my hospital medical forms. I don't feel like I can do probation and/or the dawn center even my probation officer said that, that's too much to do in my condition and he also said to try to appeal my case which was supported advice. The \$1100 dollar fine I could pay that quite quickly, because I'm working now and hitching rides to work and walking home from work, and my job is far from my house. I'm taking it easy on the job they understand so I ask you in god's name may your please help me in this problem of my guilty plea I don't do drugs I'm a good person I learn my lesson for sure, I'm working with a hurt body trying to help pay bills I got a 5 month old granddaughter my grandma in the hospital trying to beat cancer she on a line I just ask once again please help me with this problem it's not the right judgement.

P.S. thank you, have a nice day and please help me fix this problem of judgement, god bless.

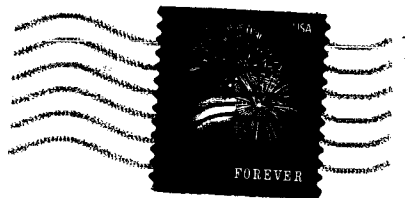
