

ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion for leave to file a motion to withdraw his guilty plea in the circuit court. Because Appellant is represented by counsel, this court will not consider Appellant's pro se filing. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989). However, Appellant may raise any arguments relating to his guilty plea in his pro se brief as permitted in *State v. Williams*, 305 S.C. 116, 406 S.E.2d 357 (1991). Any pro se brief shall be filed within twenty days.
