Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.
- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal indicating the date you received written notice of the entry of the order or judgement on appeal. No argument should be placed in the notice of appeal, and it should be in substantially the same format as shown in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal does not contain the docket number of the case from the lower court, as required by Rule 203(e)(1)(B).
