NOTICE AND REQUEST REGARDING THE RECORD ON APPEAL

Appellant respectfully notices the Court and the Respondent(s) who filed a BRIEF in the above-captioned matter that she has completed the Record on Appeal, which has been a very time-consuming document to produce. Appellant had asked the Court to extend the filing date for the Record on Appeal through **August 10, 2012**. However, Appellant has not heard back from the Court as of this date, and still must paginate the Record on Appeal pursuant to Rule 210 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure such as "**R. p. 5.**" Appellant must also review her AMENDED INITIAL BRIEF over the weekend in order to be sure that she is not leaving out any of the documents to be

included in the Record on Appeal, and must incorporate those page numbers into her FINAL BRIEF, such is the reciprocal precision and care that are required in the matter.

Appellant fully expects to turn in the Record on Appeal at the front desk during the week of **August 13, 2012**, sooner rather than later, probably on Monday or Tuesday.


Appellant had requested the extension of time due to the logistical constraints of working a job, managing a household, and constraints on her budget, as it will take approximately \$800 for Kinko's to publish the requisite 15 copies of the Record on Appeal as well as the 15 copies of Appellant's FINAL BRIEF. Appellant expects to have the necessary \$800 by the end of August in order to publish those 30 copies and to file and serve all of the bound copies pursuant to the rules on or before **September 10, 2012** in accordance with Appellant's Request for Extension of Time now before this Honorable Court.

Appellant is well aware that the FINAL BRIEF must match her AMENDED INITIAL BRIEF, and is already at the page limit for the FINAL BRIEF. Adding the page numbers into text of the FINAL BRIEF from the Record on Appeal will require some skill, so as not to extend the existing 50-page limit for the FINAL BRIEF.

Appellant apologizes to the Court and the Respondent(s) if these requests for extension of time have caused any inconvenience. Please be sure that Appellant has in-fact and has in good faith finished compiling, categorizing, and sorting the Record on Appeal, with pagination to follow over the weekend. Appellant expects the bound copies of the Record on Appeal to be tabbed by the printer, for ease of reference by the Court and Respondent.

The Court will please take note that I have empowered my husband to sign for me in giving this Notice, as I cannot leave my desk or take calls at work. Most assuredly, I have signed all of the filings in the matter, and my husband has served as mailer and server. This letter, however, is signed pursuant to the durable power of attorney on file in the public, and a copy of which is hereby attached. My husband has my full authorization to sign this particular Notice and Request on my behalf, as I cannot leave my desk at this point to sign the letter, and I feel that I am on deadline to Notice the Court and Respondent(s) in good faith.
