This matter is a forfeiture proceeding pursuant to Article III, Chapter 53, Title 44, South Carolina Code of Laws (2003), as amended.

Plaintiff is the Solicitor for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit. The action was initiated by way of Summons, Complaint, Seizure Warrant, Notice of Seizure and Notice of Hearing filed **September 30, 2013**, seeking forfeiture of the Defendant property to the State of South Carolina.

Copies of the Summons, Complaint, Seizure Warrant, Notice of Seizure and Notice of Hearing was served on the Defendant as evidenced by the Affidavit of Personal Service reflecting service was accomplished on the Defendant, **TODDRIQUE DEQUIL HENDERSON** on **October 15, 2013**. The Affidavit of Personal Service was filed with the Clerk of Court for **Florence County** on **October 21, 2013**. An Answer and/or other responsive pleadings was filed by or on behalf of the Defendant on **November 15, 2013**.

A non-jury trial was held on **March 30, 2015**, before the **Honorable William H. Seals, Jr.**. Present was Stephen L. Hill, Esquire, representing the State, **R. Coit Yarborough, Esquire**, Guardian ad Litem, and defendant, **TODDRIQUE DEQUIL HENDERSON**. Deputies **Angel Clark** and **Jake Chamberlain** of the **Florence County Sheriff's Office** testified on behalf of the State. The defendant presented two witnesses and the defendant testified on his own behalf. After hearing all of the testimony, The Court confirmed the State's seizure.



Based upon the foregoing, I find that the Damages which are the subject of this matter are liquidated in nature and, therefore, I conclude that the State's seizure is confirmed, judgment in the amount set forth is appropriate, and that the judgment is hereby satisfied.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED

1. That the following Liquidated Damages be, and hereby are, forfeited to the State of South Carolina pursuant to S.C. Code Ann 44-53-0530 (2003), as amended:  
**One Thousand Six Hundred Forty-six and NO/100's Dollars (\$1,646.00) in US Currency.**
2. That the **Florence County Sheriff's Office** is declared to be the seizing agency.
3. That the Twelfth Judicial Circuit Solicitor's Office is declared to be the prosecuting agency.
4. Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann 44-53-0530 (2003), as amended, and by agreement between the seizing and prosecuting agencies, the first One Thousand Dollars of seized monies shall be disbursed to the seizing agency.
5. Any monies in excess of One Thousand Dollars should be disbursed as set forth in S.C. Code Ann 44-53-0530 (2003), as amended.
6. That all forfeited property or proceeds from the sale of forfeited property must be used as provided for in S.C. Code Ann 44-53-0530 (2003), as amended.
7. That the Damages of this matter are liquidated in nature, the Defendant is in default, judgment in the amount set forth is appropriate, and is hereby satisfied.
