

ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari following the denial of petitioner's application for post-conviction relief.

Petitioner's counsel asserts that the petition is without merit and requests permission to withdraw from further representation. Petitioner has filed a *pro se* petition and a *pro se* motion to exceed the page limit.

After careful consideration of the record as required by *Johnson v. State*, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), we deny the petition and grant counsel's request to withdraw. We further deny petitioner's *pro se* motion to exceed the page limit as unnecessary because the excess pages are not part of petitioner's *pro se* petition, but copies of petitioner's trial transcript already provided to the Court in the Appendix.
