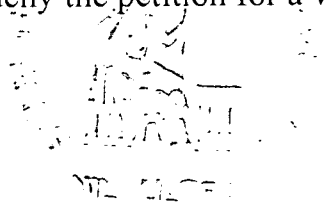



ORDER

Petitioner's first application for post-conviction relief was denied by Judge Young. An appeal was not perfected. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order of Judge Dickson finding petitioner is entitled to a belated review of Judge Young's order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991). We grant the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Dickson's order, dispense with further briefing, and proceed with a belated review of Judge Young's order.

We deny the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Young's order.
