
The appellant Rhonda Meisner respectfully requests the Court of Appeals accept the RECORD ON APPEAL that has been filed with the Court without two items noted on the designated matter of the RECORD by the Appellant. The appellant, Rhonda Meisner suggested two items in her designation of matter which (1) closing instructions from Lehman Bros. Bank and (2) the Supreme Court's administrative Order which she believed was submitted to the lower court. Upon further review, the Appellant confirmed neither item was presented to the lower court and is therefore not eligible for the record pursuant to S.C. App. Ct. Rule 210(c).

The appellant believes the omission of the two items proposed by the appellant in the designation of matter will not prejudice the respondents in any way, if the Court approves the omission. First, the respondents like the appellant did not notice the initial error in the appellants designation of matter. Second, the respondents did not make an objection to the inclusion of the suggested documents not presented to the lower court Third, the only one prejudiced by the error is the appellant because she is unable to point to the record the instructions and the Supreme Court's administrative Order.

The failure of the appellant to notice the mistake was certainly unintentional and requests the Court of Appeals accept the RECORD with the above omissions as well as the new certificate of appellant indicating the RECORD includes all items designated by any party. For the above reasons the appellant respectfully requests her motion be granted to accept the RECORD as filed.
