

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jeffrey N. Grimes v. State in this Court on March 30, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Mark McCoy v. State with this Court on March 25, 2015. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Vincent Missouri in the Court of Appeals on March 23, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Christina Hudson v. State in this Court on March 16, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel is striving to limit the number of extensions requested. Counsel is attempting to complete the cases with the most number of extensions first.

4. As indicated by consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.




