In lieu of a formal Petition for Rehearing, I wanted to bring a possible typographical error to the Court's attention. In the opinion in *State v. Odom*, Op. No. 27517 (S.C. Sup. Ct. filed April 22, 2015), this Court on page 7 stated: "Despite the prosecutor's **candid omission** that she was irritated with Huff" (Emphasis added). I believe the Court intended to state the prosecutor's candid **admission** instead of omission. Again, I just wanted to bring this typographical error to the Court's attention.
