On November 18, 2014, appellant informed counsel of a hearing in September 2012. Counsel emailed Shawn Campbell, appellant's trial lawyer, and asked him for any information about the hearing. Counsel told Mr. Campbell in the email that if the hearing was anything more substantial than a preliminary hearing, a transcript may be needed to prepare the appeal.

Mr. Campbell replied via email within thirty minutes. He replied that videotaped testimony of two witnesses was taken who were in poor health in case they passed away before trial. He stated that both of these witnesses ultimately testified at trial.

Counsel then, on that same day, wrote appellant informing him of what Mr. Campbell had said and told him I would not order the transcript because I saw no need and did not feel his case should be postponed.

If the Court, in conducting its Anders review, believes that this transcript should be ordered and reviewed, counsel will be happy to comply.
