

Please find enclosed the Motion to Compel heard before the Honorable Benjamin H. Culbertson Georgetown County Courthouse Georgetown, South Carolina. This Motion to Compel Transcript Hearing was held on December 19, 2012.

The Withholding of this Certified Court Record is a breach of Contract by Attorney Bobby G. Frederick, Esquire. See *Teeford v. Lesesnee*, 541 S.E.2d 847.


of the charged offense.
