ORDER

Petitioner's counsel has advised this Court that he cannot provide the explanation required by Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Although counsel has advised petitioner of his right to submit a *pro se* explanation under *Dennison v. State*, 371 S.C. 221, 639 S.E.2d 35 (2006), petitioner has not filed a *pro se* explanation.

Accordingly, based on the failure of petitioner to show that there is an arguable basis for asserting that the determination by the lower court was improper, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
