MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPEAL

Pursuant to Rule 260(c), SCACR, Appellant Greenlawn Funeral Home ("Greenlawn") hereby moves this Court to Withdraw the Appeal in this matter. The appeal in this matter arises from the denial of a Motion to Compel Arbitration. The Notice of Appeal in this matter was timely filed following the trial court's denial of Appellant's Motion to Compel Arbitration. Appellant served and filed its Initial Appellant's Brief on August 25, 2014. On October 6, 2014, Respondents filed a Motion for an Extension of Time in which to File their Initial Brief, pending mediation of the underlying suit, which was to take place on October 19, 2014.

The parties were unable to resolve the case via mediation, so Respondents' Initial Brief was filed in November of 2014. The Record on Appeal in this matter was filed on November 21,

2014. Appellant's Final Brief and Final Reply Brief were both filed on November 26, 2014.

Prior to Respondents filing their Final Briefs, counsel for Respondents moved to be relieved. This Court granted the Motion; and, in an Order filed February 13, 2015, required Respondents to obtain counsel within thirty days. By letter dated March 18, 2015, G. Robin Alley entered her appearance on behalf of Respondents in this matter.

Since that time, the parties have entered into a settlement agreement which disposes of the issues dispositive of this appeal. Accordingly, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court allow it to withdraw its appeal in this matter.


