I am writing this to you by joint agreement with Mr. Brett Bayne who will be representing the Defendants/Appellants/Respondents in the above-referenced appeals. We had participated in the voluntary workers' compensation mediation program which failed at the first of May. I believe through some misunderstanding of my previous requests to the Court that we be given to the end of May to complete mediation, that the Court actually issued an Order setting May 2th for the Initial Briefs to be filed by.


