
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as a response to respondent's letter dated May, 11 2015 regarding postponement of the court's decision on the appellants counsel's motion to withdraw as counsel. I misread the college's intent to meet regarding the initial meeting request to discuss and resolve issues before the court.
