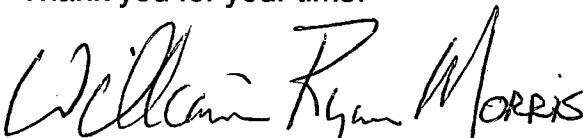
Motion for Panel Review Case # 2014-002580-order dated May 8, 2015

This is my third letter to the Court of Appeals. If you review everything I have sent this court and the judge in the first case you will understand why I'm having a very hard time understanding why I, as a land owner (619 feet) on Doodle Hill Lane, have lost 5 feet of my easement due to this case that I was not included in!!?? I need to be made to understand why this has happened. I have sent you everything that shows me as the legal owner of this property and I am still not being recognized in this case. I also have shown you that there was a mistake made with the ownership of my property as the court case was written naming the parties which states that William Johnson owns the property and not me. I own the land, NOT William Johnson! Of course he was written as a defendant for Joseph V. Johnson. He's his brother. WHY is William Johnson's name even on this case? He doesn't live on this road. He sold me the house and property on 121 Doodle Hill Lane on Jan. 07, 2013 before this case was even heard before Judge Watson. I have tried to convince his court and yours now that this is a mistake and no one is listening to me! I have sent you all the paperwork and legal documents that prove this to be the truth. Please explain to me why this injustice is being allowed to happen.

Allan Barnette is my neighbor and at the time he was a overseer for the Johnson land. Allan Barnette, Clyde Morris, Joseph Johnson and I are the only people that own land on Doodle Hill Lane. I am the fourth person that owns land on this road and I am not taking either side of the dispute. My dispute here is that my easement is being taken away from me and I'm not even included in on it! Once again, I payed for a 30 foot easement with this land and I need to know why I now only have 25 ft.! 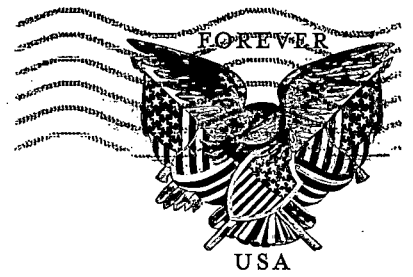
