TO: THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA
COURT OF APPEALS

COMES NOW the Appellants/Respondents, William McFarland and Jennifer McFarland, by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and move this Honorable Court for an additional extension of thirty (30) days' time to file/serve the Appellants' Initial Brief of Appellants/Respondents and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

The transcript in this matter was received on March 25, 2015. Based on the Court's letter of February 5, 2015, and the briefing schedule established therein, the original deadline to file the Appellants' Initial Brief of the Appellants/Respondents was therefore thirty days from March 25, 2015, making it due April 24, 2015. Previously, via letter-request, the Appellants/Respondents sought a 30-day extension of its briefing deadline, which the Court granted by order filed May 1, 2015, extending such deadline through May 26, 2015.

In light of other time commitments, the undersigned respectfully requests that Appellants/Respondents' deadline for serving/filing their initial brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal be extended by 30 days from May 26, 2015, i.e., through June 25, 2015. Respectfully, Appellants/Respondents believe that this relief is


consistent with the interests of justice and will not work any undue prejudice upon Respondents/Appellants. **Prior to making this motion, the undersigned counsel for the Appellants/Respondents consulted with counsel for Respondents/Appellants (specifically, Michael L. Leech, Esquire), and counsel has kindly authorized the undersigned to represent to the Court that Respondents/Appellants do not object to this motion.**

WHEREFORE, Appellants/Respondents respectfully request that this Honorable Court grant an additional extension of 30 days' time to serve/file the Appellants' Initial Brief of Appellants/Respondents and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. With the extension requested herein, the new deadline for service/filing of the Appellants' Initial Brief of Appellants/Respondents and designation of matter would be June 25, 2015, according to the undersigned's calculations. Further, Appellants/Respondents respectfully request that the Court hold Appellants/Respondents' present deadline for briefing/designation of matter in abeyance until it acts upon this motion.


