**ORDER APPOINTING COUNSEL
AND SETTING THE DATE FOR
PETITIONER'S RESPONSE TO
STATE'S MOTION TO DISMISS**

Pursuant to the April 23, 2015 Order of Chief Justice Toal, this Court conducted a hearing with the Defendant present on May 22, 2015 in Moncks Corner, SC. The purpose of the hearing was to appoint counsel on this Post Conviction Relief petition for the Petitioner, who is an inmate presently incarcerated on death row.

With the consent of the petitioner, the Court appoints Teresa L. Norris as lead counsel and Elizabeth A. Franklin-Best as co-counsel on the above-captioned petition for post conviction relief.

The Court inquired of the parties about scheduling. Senior Assistant Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka indicated that the State intends to file either a motion to dismiss and/or a motion for summary judgment on Wednesday, May 27, 2015.

The Court hereby grants the petitioner and his counsel ninety (90) days from May 27, 2015 to file the petitioner's response to the State's Motion(s) to Dismiss and/or Summary Judgment.
