

Mr. Riley Brown received a traffic ticket on 04/06/2014. He had his court date set for 04/25/2014 at 10:00 a.m... Mr. Brown came to court and requested a jury trial, request in file). Mr. Brown had his case scheduled for a jury strike on 05/16/2014 and was mailed the summons to 1810 Allendale Benedict Ct. Apt C5 Columbia, SC 29204. Mr. Brown came for his jury strike on 05/16/2014, state was not present and jury was struck. Mr. Brown was informed that he would be sent a trial date, stated that his address was the same, Mr. Brown also made a Motion and request for Rule 5. The Court assisted Mr. Brown in forwarding a copy of the request to Allendale County Sheriff Deputy B. Tarter. Mr. Brown was sent a Jury Trial Summons for September 26, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.

On September 26, 2014 Mr. Brown was scheduled for a Jury Trial. Mr. Brown's failed to show for his Jury Trial, his mail was not returned to the Magistrate's office, nor did the Magistrate office receive a phone call or a request for a continuance. Mr. Brown's trial began at 10:20 a.m. in his absence. The State agreed to go forward with 3 jurors. (14 summons were sent out, only 3 jurors came for the trial). The Jury was sworn in, instructed by Judge Willard D. Branch Jr., following Court Rules and Procedures. Deputy Sheriff B. Tarter was sworn in, gave his testimony, statements to the Jury. Rested his case. Judge Willard D. Branch Jr. instructed the jury as to the law, following Court Rules and Procedures. Jury was then sent out for deliberation. When Jury came back from deliberation. Jury had found Mr. Brown guilty of speeding. (Verdict Form in file)

Mr. Brown in filing his appeal states that he was not notified of his jury trial. Mr. Brown came to his jury strike on 05/16/2014. Attached to his appeal is a copy of the NRVC Notice. All have the same address. All notices to Mr. Brown sent to 1810 Allen Benedict Ct. Apt C5 Columbia SC 29204
