My desire is to have my appeal rights back,  
It is my contention that due to my tardiness (shame  
induced) to me that I have neglected to use  
my full rights.

That under *Boddie v. Connecticut*, 91 S.Ct. 780, I am indigent, see *Harrison v. Harrison*, 373 S.C. 529, 646 S.E.2d 180 (S.C. App. 2007).
