

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant in the case of State v. Annetta Grant in the Court of Appeals on April 10, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Sean Echols in this Court on April 8, 2015. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Phillip Hollingsworth in the Court of Appeals on April 1, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel is striving to limit the number of extensions requested. Counsel is attempting to complete the cases with the most number of extensions first.


4. As indicated by consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


