

ORDER


Petitioner asks the Court to review the Court of Appeals' decision in *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health and Human Servs.*, 410 S.C. 273, 763 S.E.2d 638 (Ct. App. 2014). Petitioner also moves to supplement the record on appeal and asks the Court to take judicial notice of certain facts. We grant the petition for a writ of certiorari as to petitioner's Question I and deny the petition as to petitioner's Questions II and III. We deny the motion to supplement the record and decline to take judicial notice of the facts presented by petitioner. However, the Court may still take notice of supplemental legal authorities pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR. The parties shall proceed to serve and file the appendix and briefs as provided by Rule 242(i), SCACR.




