



ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to provide a copy of the order on appeal and failure to provide proof of timely service of the notice of appeal on Respondent. Appellant filed a several documents, which this Court construed together as a petition to rehear the dismissal of this appeal. Although Appellant provided a copy of the order on appeal, Appellant has failed to provide proof he *timely* served Respondent with the notice of appeal pursuant to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Accordingly, after careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. The petition for rehearing is denied.¹
