ORDER

Matthew Fullbright appeals the ALC's May 21, 2014 order remanding his grievance to the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC), claiming SCDC did not properly comply with the order on remand. On appeal, SCDC has filed a motion to remand and a motion for panel review. After careful consideration, SCDC's motions are denied. However, because the ALC's order of remand is not final, this appeal is dismissed. See S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610(A)(1) (Supp. 2014) (providing judicial review may only be sought from a *final* decision of the ALC (emphasis added)).
