
## ORDER

---

Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief was denied by Judge Cole. Because petitioner failed to provide proof of timely service of his notice of appeal from Judge Cole's order, his request for a writ of certiorari was dismissed. Petitioner now seeks a writ of certiorari from an order issued by Judge Young granting petitioner a belated review of Judge Cole's order pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).

We grant the petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Young's order, dispense with further briefing, and proceed with an *Austin* review of Judge Cole's order.

The petition for a writ of certiorari from Judge Cole's order is denied.
