1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed **Thursday, June 11, 2015**.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Dennis Williams with the Court of Appeals on May 15, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Cedric Flood v. State with this Court on May 12, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Carlton Hamilton v. State with this Court on April 28, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **thirty day extension, until July 13, 2015**. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


