

## ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal or, alternatively, to remand this appeal to the circuit court, arguing its motion to reconsider, alter or amend the circuit court's order is pending before the circuit court. After review of the motion and Appellant's return, this appeal is dismissed without prejudice. *Hudson v. Hudson*, 290 S.C. 215, 216, 349 S.E.2d 341, 341-42 (1986) ("[I]n the event timely post-trial motions are filed under Rule 59, simultaneously with or subsequent to the filing of a Notice of Appeal, the appellant shall notify the Clerk of this Court in writing. Upon receipt of such notice, the appeal shall be dismissed without prejudice. Any party can appeal within ten (10) days after the order disposing of the post-trial motions.").
