Pierce, Herns, Sloan & Wilson and I represent Defendants/Respondents E. Paul Gibson, Reisen Law Firm, and E. Paul Gibson PC. I wanted to bring to the Court of Appeals' attention an on-going issue in the above-captioned appeal. Although counsel for Appellant Darrell Edwards has been filing certificates of service with the Court of Appeals, he has not been serving any of his filings on Pierce Herns. Mr. Chauntel Bland, counsel for Appellant, initially filed a motion for an extension. This was not served on my office. When we discovered the filing after a conversation with the case clerk at your office, I had a discussion with Mr. Bland reminding him of the need to serve us.

Mr. Bland filed Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to Be Included in the Record on Appeal on May 21, 2015, along with a certificate of service indicating that the Brief and Designation were mailed to Pierce Herns on the same day. As of June 3, 2015, thirteen days after the purported service, we have still not received a copy of the Initial Appellant's Brief from Mr. Bland. His certificate of service has the correct address for Pierce Herns.


Obviously, we need to receive timely service of all filings with the Court of Appeals. I do not know what action will be required to get Mr. Bland to comply with this basic rule. Hopefully this letter will suffice. Please accept this as notice of the prior lack of service and also as notice that we will move to dismiss this appeal for failure to comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules if the practice continues.

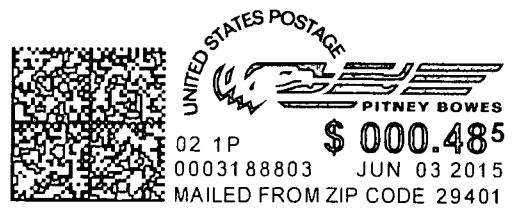
