

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Kathryn King with the Court of Appeals on May 7, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gary Grant v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on May 4, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Johnny White v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on April 30, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Reginald Murray v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on April 15, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
