This responds to your correspondence dated June 1, 2015. This document has been construed as a motion to reinstate this matter. No action will be taken on this motion for two reasons.

First, this matter was dismissed by order dated April 10, 2015. Therefore, any motion for reinstatement had to be actually received by this Court on or before April 27, 2015. Rule 260(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Accordingly, your motion for reinstatement is untimely.

Second, when no petition for restatement was received within the time provided by Rule 260(a), SCACR, the remittitur was sent to the circuit court. Rule 221, SCACR. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction and no further motions can be considered in this matter. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C.
