of six years suspended to two years probation was  
revoked. I am currently serving a 10 month Y.O.A. sentence  
at South Carolina Department of Corrections. My reason for  
filing an appeal are... My public defender was only aware  
of my case literally hours before appearing in front  
of a judge. There was absolutely no time to prepare. I was  
merely 5 whole months away from successfully completing  
my two years on probation. I was not given the choice  
on the court date to attend in-patient treatment  
of any sort. I tested positive on one drug test out of  
the entire two years I was on probation. I myself  
decided to enroll in drug & alcohol classes as to  
which I was doing very well even had proof of my  
progress. If there is any way my sentence in SCDC  
could be suspended to continuation of my probation  
and I attend in-patient treatment for 30-60 days.  
I know that I need the help and the help I need  
is not given in SCDC. Please help me with this  
matter. I have full support from my family on in-patient  
treatment and the financial help as well.

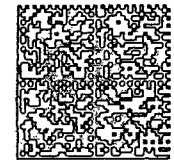
