ORDER

The State has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari to review an order granting respondent-petitioner's application for post-conviction relief. Respondent-petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari and a brief, pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), asserting he is entitled to a belated review of his direct appeal issue in accordance with *White v. State*, 263 S.C. 110, 208 S.E.2d 35 (1974).

The State's petition for a writ of certiorari is denied. Accordingly, respondent-petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari pursuant to *White v. State* is denied as moot.
