In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed on **Friday, June 5, 2015**.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Cedric Flood v. State with the Supreme Court on May 12, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Carlton Hamilton v. State with the Supreme Court on April 28, 2015.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty day extension, until July 7, 2015**. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


