MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Lynn Hunt respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 13th, 2015**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Mr. Lynn Hunt respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Shawn Reaves before this Court on May 6, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kenwood Bright v. State of South Carolina with this Court on April 29, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Travis Lamar Bowser v. State of South Carolina with this Court on April 24, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Ferris G. Singley v. State of South Carolina with this Court on April 14, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Steve Young in the Court of Appeals on April 13, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Christopher Taft before this Court on April 9, 2015.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




