The appellant filed a Notice of appeal from an order issued on November 23, 2004 and served on May 20, 2015. The Notice of appeal was timely served within thirty (30) days from receipt of the written order of Forfeiture.


Per the court order file dated June 2, 2015 it appears appellant's appeal was dismissed based solely because the court believes appellant did not attempt to set aside a default judgment.

This court should not have dismissed appellant's appeal pursuant to *Belue vs. Belue*, 276 S.C. 120, 121, 276 S.E. 2d 295, 295-96 (1981) because not once but twice appellant have attempted to set aside the default judgment by filing a motion in the circuit court that entered the default but the court has failed to rule on the motions, which both motions to set aside the default were filed in the circuit court prior to the notice of appeal.

Based on the above information, this court should reinstate appellant's notice of appeal and/or grant any other relief as deemed appropriate.



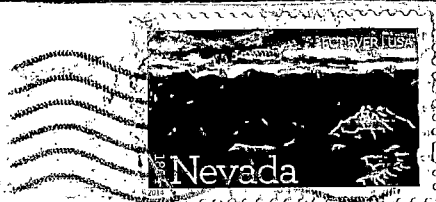

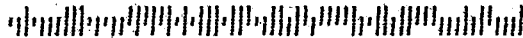
