YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to SCACR Rule
240 and 263 (b), the Appellant moves for an Order of the Court

1. 
copies of the Supplemental Record on Appeal but the Court advised that a Motion allowing for the late filing would be necessary in addition to the filing of the documents.




