AMENDED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Joseph William Dinkins respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until July 6, 2015**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Alexander Joseph William Dinkins respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. The motion for an extension was timely filed, but erroneously listed “Elder Prescott Leach” rather than “Joseph William Dinkins” as the appellant in sections 1 and 2. This motion is corrected to cure this error.



Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. O’Neal Bernard Byrdic, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on May 14, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Kathryn King with the Court of Appeals on May 7, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Gary Grant v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on May 4, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Johnny White v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on April 30, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Reginald Murray v. State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on April 15, 2015.

5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

6. Counsel for the Attorney General’s office consents to this request shown by signature below.




