## ORDER

The petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed in this matter by June 25, 2015. Petitioner now moves to file only one copy of the "brief"<sup>1</sup> and appendix.

Petitioner is granted permission to file only one copy of the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix with this Court. Petitioner must still serve a copy of the petition and appendix on opposing counsel. Petitioner is reminded that the petition and appendix must have the content specified by Rule 243(e) and (f) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).

The request to exceed the twenty-five page limit for a petition for a writ of certiorari under Rule 243(e)(3), SCACR, is denied.
