

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on July 31, 2013 the Grand Jurors of Edgefield County present upon their oath:

That MAURICE ANTHONY ODOM, did in Edgefield County on or about October 17, 2007, willfully and unlawfully enter, during the nighttime, without consent and with the intent to commit a crime therein, a building, to wit: the IGA Foodstore, Johnston, SC, having previously been convicted on two or more occasions of the crime of burglary, in violation of §16-11-0312(B)(2) and (3), South Carolina Code of Law, as amended, with penalties provided for in §16-11-312(C)(2), South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
