
**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RETURN TO APPELLANTS'-
RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR ENTRY OF A SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER**

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Respondents-Appellants Hugh K. Leatherman, in his representative capacity and as President Pro Tempore of the South Carolina Senate, and James H. Lucas, as Speaker Pro Tempore of the South Carolina House of Representatives (hereinafter “the Senate and the House”), hereby move this Court for an order granting a ten (10) day extension of time to file a Return to Appellants’-Respondents’ Motion for Entry of a Supplemental Order. This is the Senate and the House’s first request for an extension.

The Senate and the House’s Return is currently due on June 29, 2015. With the requested extension, the Return will be due on July 9, 2015. Counsel for the State and the Governor have informed the undersigned that they join in this request and ask that any extension extend to those parties.
