This will confirm my telephone conversation regarding the request, and now motion, by Respondents-Appellants Leatherman and Lucas for a 10 day extension within which to respond to the Appellants-Respondents' Motion for Supplemental Order. Elizabeth (Betsy) Gray and I exchanged both voice and email messages this afternoon but have not spoken directly.
