Dear Ms. Harmon:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 210(d), SCACR. Specifically, the index is printed on the back side of the cover of the record on appeal.
- The document is not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- Per Rule 210(c), SCACR, each page of the record on appeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index.
- Per Rule 267(e), SCACR, the covers of the record on appeal shall be of a material not less than 50 pound weight and not glassine.
- The caption is reversed from the example shown in Rule 267(a), SCACR.
