**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE THE APPELLANT'S INITIAL BRIEF  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED  
IN THE RECORD ON APPEAL**

COMES NOW, Jack B. Swerling, attorney for the Appellant, requesting an extension to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. The Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal is due to be filed on June 19, 2015.

This is the second request for an extension. Counsel is in need of an extension for sixty (60) days for the following reasons:

1. Counsel received another transcript in another matter in the case of State v. Hoover on June 8, 2015, which means that he has to read two transcripts and prepare two briefs in the near future.
2. Counsel has a date certain trial in the Richland County General Sessions Court in the matter of State v. Waklatsi commencing July 13, 2015, which is expected to last one week. Counsel has been earnestly preparing for that trial.
3. Counsel has been noticed for a trial in the Richland County General Sessions Court on July 22, 2015 in the matter of State v. Livingston.
4. Counsel has been noticed for trial in the Richland County General Sessions Court on August 20, 2015 in matter of State v. Sibert.
5. The undersigned counsel was not trial counsel in either of the appeals pending before the Court (State v. Gurley and State v. Hoover), so additional time is also required for counsel to read the transcripts, meet with the defendants concerning the transcripts and prepare the briefs.

As a result of the above circumstances, Appellate counsel requests an additional sixty (60) days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.

Appellate counsel's paralegal, Kellie A. Switzer, has consulted with Salley W. Elliott, Senior Assistant Deputy Attorney General, and she has no objection to any requests for extensions and consents to this request by counsel.

WHEREFORE, counsel prays the Court will grant a sixty (60) day extension,

until August 18, 2015, to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.




