1. **Petitioner Ronald Jarmuth, Pro Se, Moves for an Order of this Court**
 - (a) **granting an exception to SCRAP Rule 242(d)(4) permitting Petitioner to exceed the twenty five page limit stated in the rule, so as to allow for the inclusion of an Index and Table of Authorities not required by SCRAP Rule 242 (d); or**
 - (b) **in the alternative, granting permission to remove the Index and Table of Authorities included in the Petition so that the Petition (including Cover) will conform to the page limit of the rule.**
2. **On April 24, 2015 the Court of Appeals entered an Order denying rehearing. On May 12, 2015, eleven days early, Petitioner personally appeared and filed the Petition with the Clerk of the Supreme Court, allowing ample time for correction if errors were discerned. Petitioner personally asked if the document conformed to the Rule before filing the Petition, since ample time remained to correct any error.**
3. **The Rule requires inclusion of (1) Certificate of Counsel; (2) a list of the Questions Presented; (3) a Statement of the Case; and (4) Argument. There is no requirement for an Index nor for a Table of Authorities. These were provided to facilitate locating the required elements and to conform to the requirement in Briefs to have a Table of Authorities and an Index (which in those pleadings do not count against the page limit). If the Index and Table of Authorities are removed the Petition, including the Cover, fully conforms to the rule as to page length and contents. Per the Rule, the Certificate of Service is not part of the Petition (although required) and if the Court desires, will be physically separated from the Petition.**
4. **Conclusion.**

The interest of justice will be served by permitting Petitioner to either retain

the Index and Table of Authorities or to remove same so as to conform to the Rule.


