On behalf of the Respondent South Carolina Public Charter School District ("District"), I am writing to object to Appellants' Final Brief. This Court has dismissed the appeal. While Appellants have moved to reinstate the appeal, and Respondents have objected to any reinstatement, the Court has not re-opened the matter. Thus, the final brief has been improperly filed in a dismissed action, showing continued disregard for this Court's rules and providing a further basis upon which the appeal should not be reinstated.


I am also writing regarding the filing of confidential information by Appellants in the Record on Appeal. Specifically, Volume IV of the Record on Appeal, as served by Appellant, contains confidential information about students in violation of the Supreme Court's standing order regarding personal data identifiers and the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), 20 U.S.C. § 1232g and its implementing regulations. By letter dated May 20, 2015, the undersigned asked counsel for Appellants to substitute the Volume IV he appears to have filed with the redacted version filed in the Administrative Law Court. However, Appellants' counsel has failed to file the redacted version or respond to the request to do so. This is yet another reason to refuse to reinstate this appeal, but requires correction as soon as possible in any event in order to prevent disclosure of student information. The District requests that the Court Order Appellant to file the redacted version within ten (10) days or, in the alternative,

allow the District to provide the redacted version of Volume IV to substitute in to the Court's file.
