
This responds to your letter dated June 9, 2015. Although you have not provided the case number for the direct appeal or the post-conviction relief cases, it appears that the following appellate cases are related to your request:

- (1) Appellate Case Number 2002-023051. This was the direct appeal from the guilty plea in 2000GS3200689 (murder). Since this case was decided by the South Carolina Court of Appeals, you will need to request the documents in that case from the Court of Appeals.
- (2) Appellate Case Number 2005-033836. This was the appellate proceedings relating to the post-conviction relief case in 2003CP3201863. Since this case was decided by the South Carolina Court of Appeals, you will need to request the documents in that case from the Court of Appeals.
- (3) Appellate Case Number 2012-209487. This was the appellate proceeding relating to the post-conviction relief case in 2008CP3203561. This case was dismissed by this Court based on your failure to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

I can provide a copy of the filings made in this case for \$16.40. This represents the cost of copying 56 pages at our standard rate of 25 cents a page plus a mailing fee of \$2.40.
