

ORDER

This court dismissed this appeal on April 3, 2015, and the appeal was remitted on April 21, 2015. Respondent filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, seeking payment for attorney's fees and costs. After careful consideration of the parties' filings, the motion for costs is granted in the amount of \$1,054.00 against Appellant. *See* Rule 222(b), SCACR (allowing a party to recover \$1,000 in attorney's fees, specifically permitting a party to recover the cost of the court reporters transcript, and stating that any costs other than those specifically enumerated by the Rule "will generally not be allowed except in the most extraordinary of circumstances."). The lower court or tribunal is directed to add this award of costs to the remittitur.
