MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Corey Brown respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Corey Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Beneco Ganson with this Court on May 12, 2015. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Shawn Reaves in the Supreme Court on May 6, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kenwood Bright v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on April 29, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Travis Lamar Bowser v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on April 24, 2015. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Ferris G. Singley v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on April 14, 2015.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case


based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the brief be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
