MOTION AND MEMORANDUM OF LAW

IN SUPPORT OF PETITION TO SET

BAIL.

THE PETITIONER, STANLEY GOLSON, PRO-SE MOVES FOR AN ORDER SETTING BAIL  
PURSUANT TO RULE 227(I), SCACR. THIS MOTION IS BASED ON THE FOLLOWING  
GROUNDS:

1. PETITIONER WENT TO TRIAL TO INDICTMENTS CHARGING TWO VIOLATIONS OF  
THE STATE DRUG LAWS BEFORE THE HONORABLE J. KLOX MATTHEW ON APRIL 3, AND 4  
07.
2. THE VERDICT WAS ENTERED IN THE LEXINGTON COUNTY COURT OF GENERAL  
SESSIONS, PETITIONER-DEFENDANT WAS SENTENCED TO LIFE WITHOUT PAROLE.
3. THE PETITIONER-DEFENDANT FILED AN APPLICATION FOR POST CONVICTION RELIEF  
(PCR) IN THE LEXINGTON COUNTY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS ON SEPTEMBER  
2010 THAT HIS DEFENSE COUNSEL WAS INEFFECTIVE, FOR NOT OBTAINING

4. AT AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING ON APRIL 17, 2013 THE HON.  
FRANK ADDY JR. RULED THE NEXT DAY, BY A FORM-4- THAT  
I DID NOT PROVE THE 2-PRONG TEST OF STRECKLAND V. WASHINGTON.
5. ON FEBRUARY 17, 2014 JUDGE FRANK ADDY ISSUE A WRITTEN ORDER  
WHEREIN HE DENIED, ME POST CONVICTION RELIEF.
6. THE COURT APPOINTED ATTORNEY CHARLES T. BROOKS, FILED NOTICE  
OF INTENT TO APPEAL TO JUDGE FRANK ADDY'S ORDER ON MARCH, 2014
7. PETITIONER-DEFENDANT ASSERTS, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF THAT HE IS  
ENTITLED TO BAIL BEING SET IN HIS CASE AND SHOULD BE RELEASED  
FROM CUSTODY ON THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS.
  - (A.) THE PETITIONER-DEFENDANT HAS BEEN INCARCERATED FOR OVER NINE  
YEARS.
  - (B.) THE PETITIONER-DEFENDANT PLANS TO LIVE WITH HIS GRANDMOTHER  
MRS VIOLA MARTEN, IF RELEASED ON BAIL AND PLANS TO SUPPORT  
HIMSELF LAWFULLY BY WORKING, LABOR WORK AND A SMALL COMMUNITY  
STORE AND DETAIL SHOP.
  - (C.) THE PETITIONER-DEFENDANT HAS STRONG FAMILY TIES TO THE COMMUNITY  
INCLUDING HIS GRANDMOTHER, MRS VIOLA MARTEN, AUNTS, UNCLE,  
A SISTER AND BROTHER OTHER RELATIVES WHO RESIDE IN COLORADO

D. THE PETITIONER-DEFENDANT WAS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE BROOKLAND BAPTIST CHURCH IN WEST COLUMBIA UP TO THE TIME HE WAS INCARCERATED.

E. UPON REMAND, OF A NEW TRIAL, PETITIONER WOULD PRESUMABLY SEEK FULL DISCLOSURE PURSUANT TO BRADY V. MARYLAND, AND RULE 5(A) OF THE SCRCRP.

F. UPON REMAND, THE PETITIONER WISH TO TAKE THE PLEA OFFER AT FIRST OF 10-YRS TIME SERVE, AND WOULD SEEK TO ENFORCE THE SAME. MS SALLY J. HENRY WAS ATTORNEY.

G. THE STATE CONCEDED THAT THE PETITIONER WAS ILLEGALLY AND WRONGFULLY IMPRISONMENT, AND TRIAL COUNSEL, AND PCR JUDGE AND TRIAL JUDGE ERRORED, AND TRIAL ATTORNEY WAS INEFFECTIVE, AND PETITIONER PROVED AT PCR HEARING, TRIAL COUNSEL WAS INEFFECTIVE.

H. PETITIONER SUBMITS THERE IS EVIDENCE IN THE RECORD WHICH SUPPORTS THE WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS, THE ORDER OF THE SUPREME COURT, DATE APRIL 22 2015, THAT THE CHARGES SHOULD BE REMANDED FOR A NEW TRIAL AND THAT THE DECISION OF THE COURT IS PROPER.

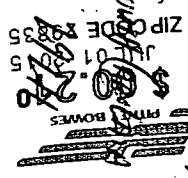

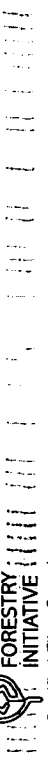
